

When installing this exhaust system make sure to use proper safety precautions. Use jack stands when under the truck, set parking brake, block tires and use safety glasses and gloves.

DO NOT WORK WITH HOT PIPES!

SUGGESTED TOOLS:

1/2", 9/16", 15mm Socket & Wrench, WD-40, Jack Stand



TO REMOVE YOUR STOCK EXHAUST, REMOVE IT FROM THE 2 BOLT FLANGE LOCATED JUST IN FRONT OF THE MUFFLER AND REMOVE HANGERS FROM RUBBER GROMMETS BY PULLING EXHAUST TOWARDS THE REAR OF THE VEHICLE, USE WD-40 TO AID IN REMOVAL, LEAVE GROMMETS IN PLACE.



INSTALL HEADPIPE # A
INTO STOCK PIPE. THE END
OF THE PIPE SHOULD BE AT
THE 12 O'CLOCK POSITION,.
INSERT WELDED HANGERS
INTO RUBBER GROMMET.
ATTACH WITH BOLT KIT #F.
DO NOT TIGHTEN. REMOVE
THE HANGER FRO THE FRAME
& RELOCATE TO THE HOLES
JUST TO THE LEFT OF THE
OTHER HOLES YOU WILL
NEED TO PRY THE INSERTS
OUT & RE-INSTALL SEE
PHOTO



INSTALL MUFFLER # B ONTO HEADPIPE 1 ½" TO 2". USE CLAMP # E TO SECURE MUFFLER TO HEADPIPE. DO NOT TIGHTEN. USE A JACK STAND TO HOLD UP THE MUFFLER. MUFFLER INLET IS LOOKING INTO THE LOUVERS. OUTLET SHOULD BE AT THE 10 O'CLOCK POSITION.



INSTALL OVERAXLE
TAILPIPE #C INTO
MUFFLER 1 ½" TO 2".
INSERT HANGERS INTO
RUBBER GROMMETS.USE
CLAMP #E TO SECURE
PIPE TO MUFFLER.DO
NOT TIGHTEN.



INSTALL YOUR STAINLESS TIP TO YOUR DESIRED LOOK. NOW GO BACK AND TIGHTEN ALL CLAMPS STARTING FROM THE FRONT AND WORKING YOUR WAY BACK.

MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A 1" CLEARANCE ON ALL RUBBER BRAKE LINES, SHOCK BOOTS, TIRES, FUEL LINES, ETC..
