

EXHAUST INSTALLATION

WHEN INSTALLING THIS EXHAUST SYSTEM MAKE SURE TO USE PROPER SAFETY PRECAUTIONS.USE JACK STANDS WHEN UNDER TRUCK, ALONG WITH SAFETY GLASSES.DO NOT WORK WITH HOT PIPES!

SUGGESTED TOOLS: 15MM SOCKET, 9/16 SOCKET, HACKSAW, JACKSTAND

- 1. Remove stock exhaust from behind the catalytic converter. Use jack stands to support converter. You will want to keep the converter supported so it wont drop.
- 2. Lay out the GIBSON EXHAUST SYSTEM on the floor so it looks like the drawing.
- 3. Install hangers #F, G, H. Attach band clamp #I into rubber grommets.
- 4. Slide muffler #A with inlet onto the converter through band clamp. Use a jack stand to support the muffler and clamp down to front pipe with clamp #E. Muffler inlet is looking into the louvers. Do not tighten.
- 5. Install the overaxle tailpipe #B to outlet of muffler and attach to hanger #F and clamp.
- 6. Slide turn out pipe #C on the tailpipe behind the rear tire. Roll turnout pipe until you have it at the correct angle for your truck attach with hanger #G and clamp.
- 7. Install stainless steel tip. Clamp down. To clean stainless tip use a scott brite pad and any stainless steel or aluminum cleaner.
- 8. When you have everything in place, tighten all bolts and clamp down.

SPECIAL NOTES:

* MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A 1" CLEARANCE ON ALL PIPES FROM ALL RUBBER BRAKE LINES, FUEL LINES, SHOCK BOOTS, TIRES, ETC.
